As part of the mission of the Gasparilla Classic, Lightning City has developed an amazing opportunity for all participating gymnasts and families to GIVE BACK to a variety of charitable causes! This exciting organization began in October of 2014 at the Fall Gasparilla. This competition was held at the Lakeland Center and had approximately 1,000 compulsory gymnasts, all of which got to participate and feel the power of giving back NEARLY \$4,500 to charitable causes! Since that first meet in 2014, The Giving Back Program has donated approximately \$22,000 to local charities! This year the Gasparilla Classic is proud to have 4,000 athletes from 22 states and 8 countries! Talk about a great opportunity to make a difference in this world! GREAT NEWS...we want YOU to be a part of this mission!

How it works: This year at the legendary Gasparilla Classic all athletes, coaches, judges, staff and volunteers will be given three tickets holding a value of \$1 each in pirate gold! Everyone will then have the opportunity to decide amongst several pre-determined charities where they would like to donate their tickets. All \$3 may go to one charity or split up into two or three. Tim was the owner of American Twisters gymnastics, USA National Team Coach, National clinician as well as Regional JO chairman and Elite Chairman during his career. Tim Rand will always be remembered for the effects he had on not only his own

athletes and coaches but the influence he made on gymnasts and coaches around the country. His lectures and videos made a huge impact on hundreds of USAG coaches that resulted in an astronomical amount of successful gymnasts at every level. His enthusiasm and love for making gymnastics better overall was contagious and his spirit will live on forever!

To honor the memory of Tim Rand, The TR Legends fund was established and has been assisting athletes, coaches and judges since 2007. All proceeds that are donated to the TR Legends fund are tax deductible and 100% of the donations go to the support of athletes, coaches and judges. The fund has paid the Eastern and JO National entry fee for all qualified Region 8 National athletes for the last 4 years as well as assisting with coaches/judges education and apparel. The name of the fund was recently changed to the TR Legends fund in order to honor all the legendary coaches/judges/friends of USA Gymnastics.
